


Kerala IT at 4th GCC Leadership Conclave 2025




India Skills Report 2026 highlights Kochi's talent strength

Kochi strengthened its position as a top talent hub, securing the 4th rank in youth employability in the India Skills Report 2026. Published by the Educational Testing Service (ETS) in collaboration with CII, AICTE, AIU, and TAGGD, the report assessed employability and skill readiness across the country. A strong, future-ready ecosystem continued to support Kochi's expanding workforce, making the city an attractive destination for global investment and a rising centre for business and technology growth.

The report also recognised Kochi as one of the leading Tier-2 cities emerging as a strong talent hub, reflecting the growing preference among employers for the region's high-skilled professionals, industry-wise hiring intent showed robust momentum across multiple sectors, including IT, pharmaceuticals and healthcare, and BFSI. This broad-based expansion of opportunities highlighted Kochi's emergence as a promising delivery hub for global operations, supported by an ecosystem that enabled both talent development and business scalability.




Kochi: preferred destination for Global Capability Centres

India's GCC - IT Talent Trends 2025 Report by Quesst examined the rapid emergence of new Global Capability Centres across India over the past 18 months. The report analysed how these organisations structured their talent strategies around supply, hiring demand, demand-supply gaps, and cost dynamics across various job families and locations. Tier-2 cities such as Kochi were highlighted as strong and capable talent hubs, well-positioned to support global capability centres and function as key secondary cities in this expanding landscape.





Thrissur showcases business and innovation potential
